DIRECTOR'S NOTE

In 2021, Caleb Parry directed Bright Star on the Zig's Main Stage. That was my first show ever at the Zig. It was my first time truly meeting the people that make this place so special. If you don't know, please enjoy this breathtaking, rollercoaster of a tale, told by a cast of absolute superstars, who handle the weight and emotion of the piece with the truest tenderness.

I'd like to thank Caleb, Morgan, and Kristin Parry for trusting me with this huge undertaking, and Dylan Panter for helping me transition into this uncharted territory. I'd also like to give an insurmountable thank you to Rylee and Macyn Martin, the best team/collaborators a Director could ask for.






